

NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that Ordinance No. 2023-3 entitled "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ESSEXVILLE TO AMEND CHAPTER 7 ENTITLED "GARBAGE AND REFUSE PICKUP" OF TITLE II, ENTITLED "UTILITIES AND SERVICES", TO REVISE SECTION 2.704, was adopted by the Essexville City Council at its regular meeting of October 10, 2023. The ordinance shall be effective October 25, 2023.

The City of Essexville ordains.....

SECTION 1: In accordance with Section 1.102 of Chapter 1 of Title I of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Essexville, Paragraph (a) of Section 2.704 of Chapter 7 of Title II is hereby amended to read as follows:

a. Unless authorized otherwise by Section 2.703, every owner or occupant of a residential unit for which City refuse collection service is afforded under this ordinance shall place all accumulated and acceptable refuse for collection by the City or its contractor. Refuse shall be placed by the owner and occupant of the residential unit at the curb in front of the residence not earlier than 5:00 p.m. of the day preceding the collection day. The owner and occupant shall not place or cause to be placed any unacceptable items for collection. No person shall place refuse materials of any kind on the premises of or in front of a residence for City collection service, except refuse originating in that residence. Containers used to transfer refuse or recycling material must be removed by the owner or occupant by 5:00pm the day following collection day.
